### Appendix A: The photo of the *Mendota*

In Winter 2003, SIDCO Conservator Bobby Willis discovered that the supposed photo of the *Pevensey* was actually that of the Union steamer *Mendota*. Somehow, the photo seen below was mistaken to be that of the *Pevensey*.

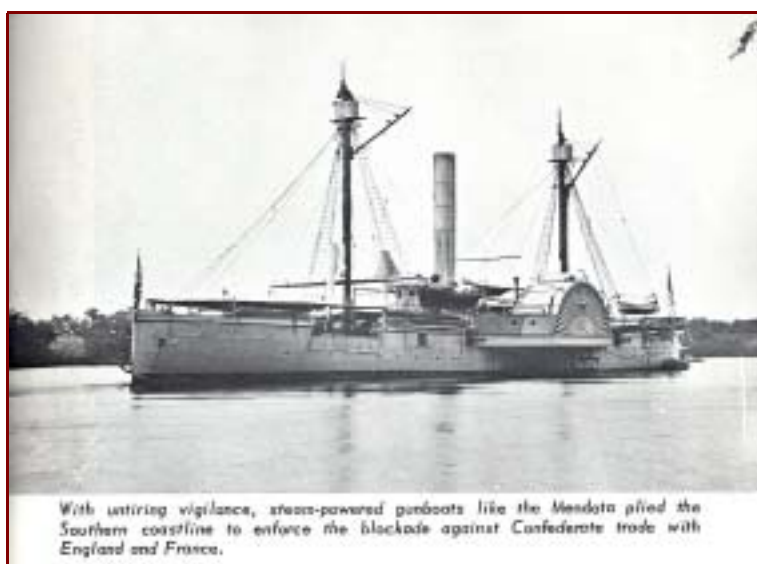
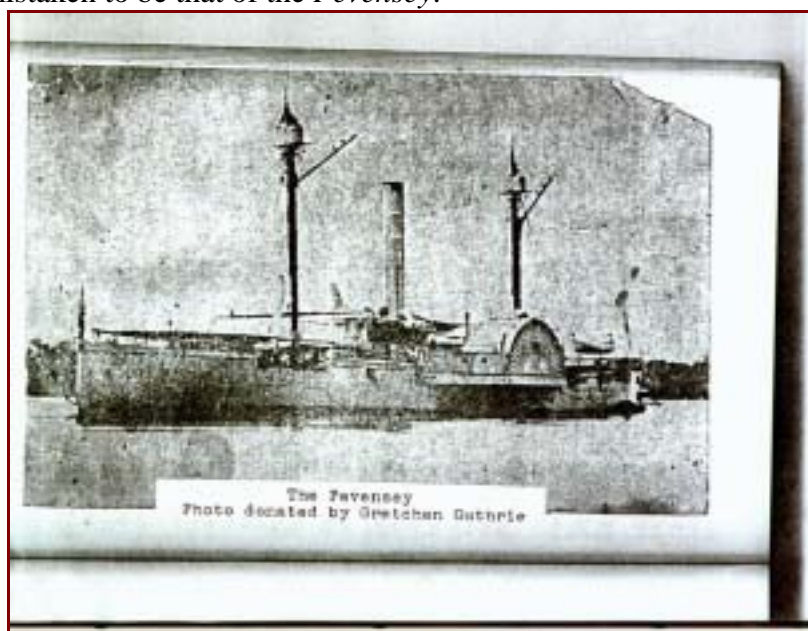


Photo No.2 was taken from the *Civil War Handbook* by William H. Price published by L.B. Prince Co. Inc., Fairfax VA, in 1961, on page 31. The real error is not apparent until you see the 3<sup>rd</sup> photo found by Mr. Willis, also of the *Mendota*, taken on the James River, as part of the Brady Collection.<sup>1</sup>

If you notice the smokestack in photo 3, it is *behind* the crankshaft and paddlewheels, which is inconsistent with the layout of the wreck at the Iron Steamer Pier. The *Mendota* had many of the same characteristics as the *Pevensey*, and the two ships could easily have been confused when seen from the same angle as photos # 1 and 2. However, the misplacement of the smokestack as seen in the third photo is undeniable proof that this is not a photo of the *S.S. Pevensey*.

The fourth photo below also shows one main 100-pounder Parrot and two smaller guns on the upper deck. We know for sure that the *Pevensey* was not armed.<sup>2</sup>

Since photo #3 from Brady's Collection shows the same ship being named the *USS Mendota* as in the other photos, *the* connection is made. *We* have shown both photos once again for the reader's own analysis.

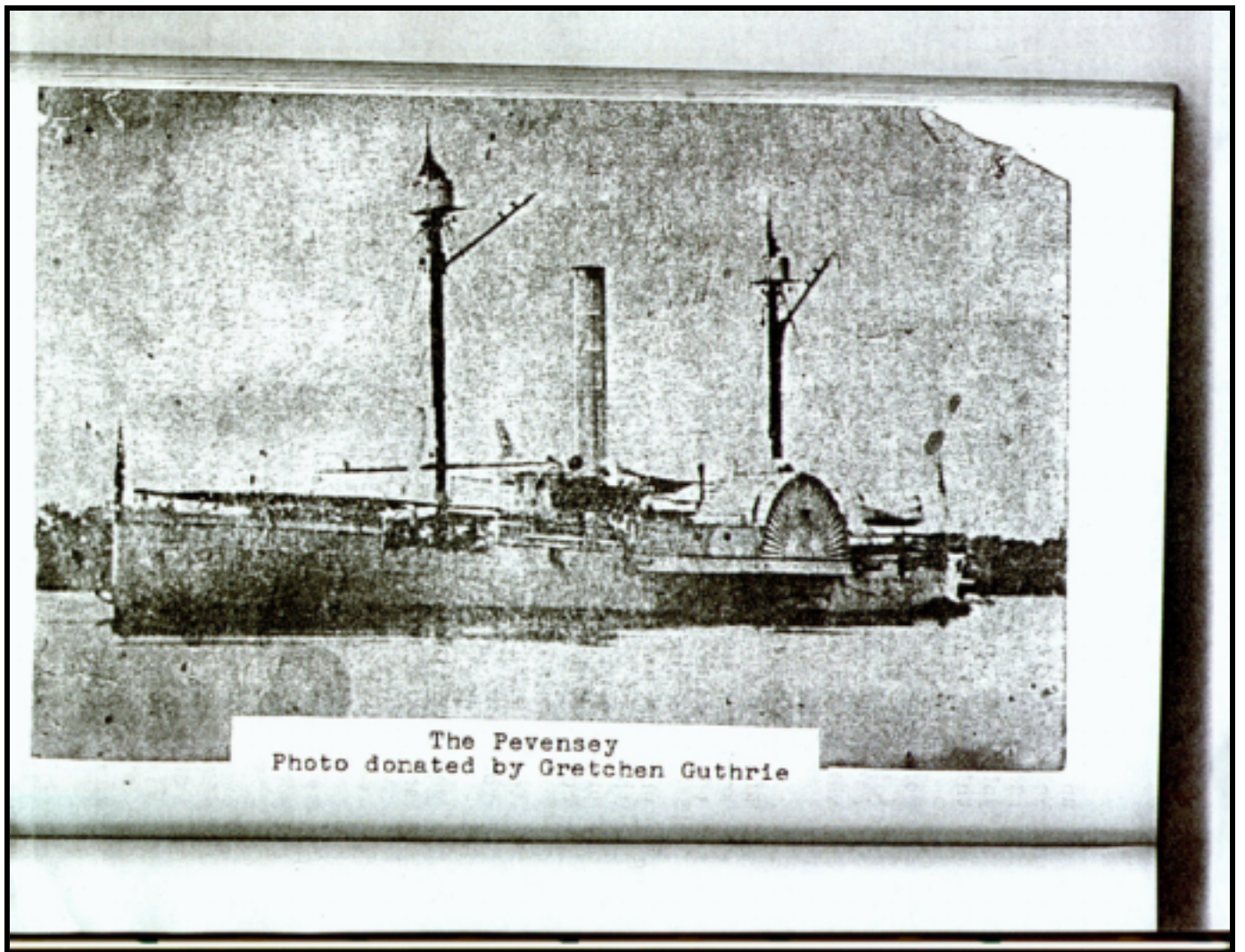

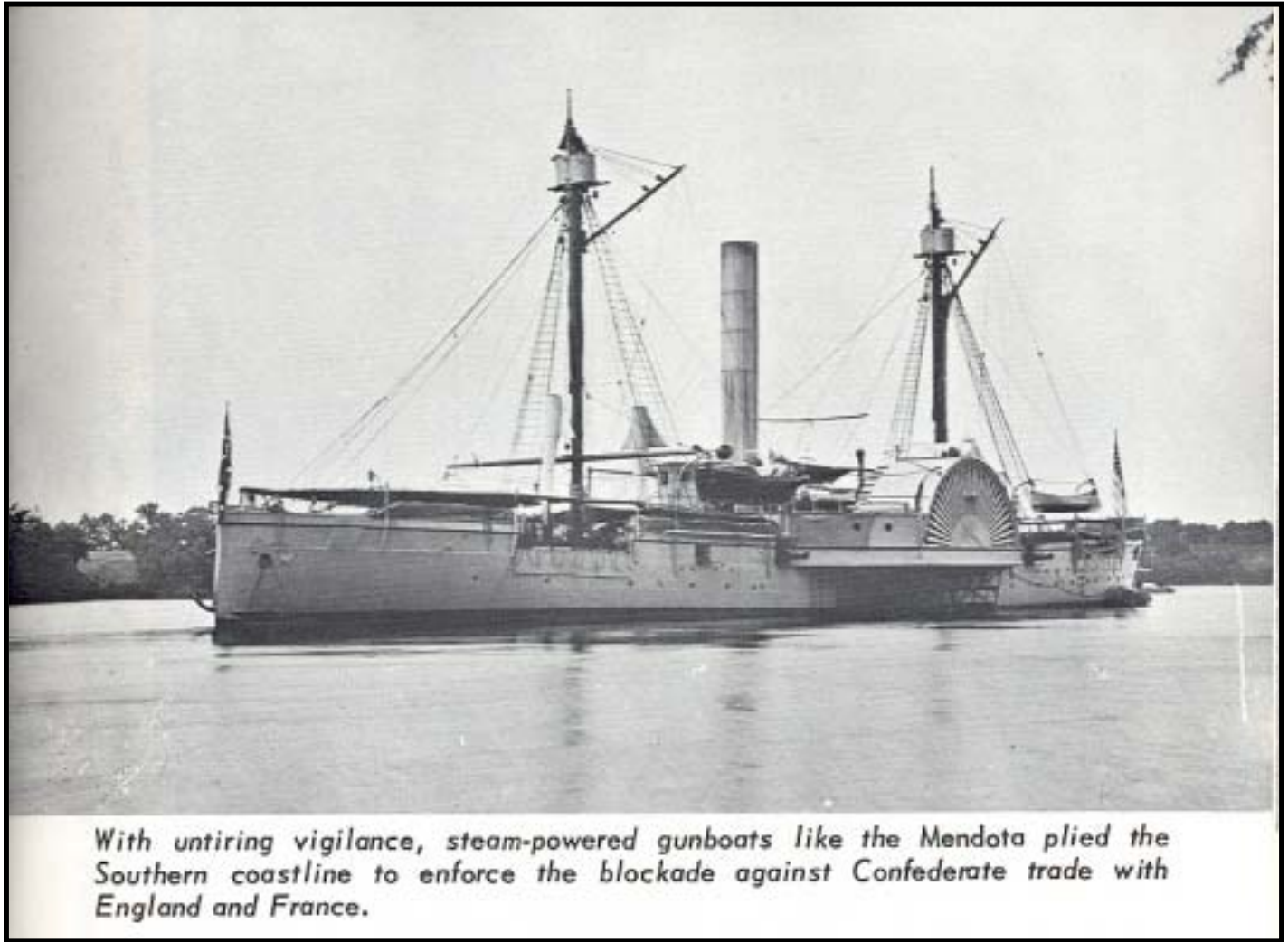
